


Complete each field. Fields marked with an asterisk are mandatory.







O Seasonal adjustment (Preferably use this one) – this method uses data from the same period in the previous year to calculate the estimates allowing for seasonal variances


O Simple average – allows you to select the date range that should be used for calculating the estimates (this is useful if there is only one "good" record to use)

O 3 month window – uses the last 3 months of data to calcualte the estimates

O 6 month window – uses the last 6 months of data to calcualte the estimates
